- 1. Your abstract should be at least 250 and at most 400 words
- 2. 2- It should have at least 3 keywords.
- 3. 3- It should be written in Times New Roman, 12 points, with single line spacing.
- 4. 4- Title, author's name and surname, affiliation and e-mail addresses should be written under the title.
- 5. There is an English summary requirement

You must send your abstract to kazdaglari@balikesir.edu.tr in doc/word format by **25/06/2023** at the latest.

FULL-TEXT SPELLING RULES

- The full text of the paper should be prepared in Microsoft Word format.
- The text of the paper should be prepared in a way that **does not exceed** 20 pages (including text, graphics, sources and all annexes).
- The writing area of each page should be arranged so that there is 2.5 cm space left, right, top and bottom.
- The paper should be written in Times New Roman font, based on left and right (leaning sideways) and with a single line spacing.
- The abstract should be at least 250 and at most 400 words in Turkish and English.
- Paper Title: 12 Font, Uppercase, bold and center
- Names of Author (s): 12 font, bold, leaning right.
- Author/Authors Affiliated Institution: 12 points to the right. Author and institution single line spacing.
- Main Headings: 12 Point leaning left, all letters capitalized and bold.
- Subtitles: 12 pt based on left, first letters capitalized and bold.
- Text: 12 pt with single line spacing based on left and right edges and 6nk paragraph spacing.
- Graphics, Table and Photo Titles: 12 pt, bold.
- A line spacing should be left between the sections of the paper text.
- The first letters of the headings of the tables and figures should be uppercase and the others should be lowercase.
- You can use any citation format you want.
